STUDENT ABSENCES

Secondary School Vaccinations in 2024

- The Secondary School Vaccine Program offers free vaccinations to Year 7 and Year 10 students.
- These vaccines provide protection against:
- Year 7 students
 - Diphtheria, tetanus and whooping cough (pertussis) one injection
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) two injections spaced by a minimum of 6 months
 Year 10 students
- Meningococcal ACWY one injection
- Parents/guardians of Year 7 and Year 10 students should look out for the vaccine consent

- complete and return the form regardless of whether your child is being vaccinated at
- The Buloke Shire Council immunisation service may contact you about the Secondary
- School Vaccine Program. Schools are authorised to provide basic parent/guardian contact details to local
- councils for this purpose. Contact the school by 28 February each year if you do not want your contact details given to the Buloke Shire Council immunisation service.


